Flight Requirements to be conducted in order and under the supervision of a Tandem Rated Instructor	
a: Five (5) Instructional tandem flights as passenger with the Instructor. Instruction should include introduction to big ears, 360-degree turns, wing-overs, techniques for launches and landings, and advice on speed to fly considerations.
b: Five (5) Instructional tandem flights as Pilot in command with the Instructor as passenger. Pilot should practise and demonstrate the above-mentioned skills to the Instructor.
c: Ten (10) additional flights, under the direction of the Instructor, as Pilot in Command with a passenger that is at least PG2 certified
d: Pilot has sufficient Competency and Knowledge to undertake Tandem Flights
