2. NZHGPA Approved Examiner must:
 - a. Check Pilot's Log Book to confirm Flight Log Requirements.
 - b. Sight First Aid Certificate is in date and meets the NZHGPA OPM requirements.
3. Recommending pilots must support that the applicant meets:
 - a. The standard expected of an instructor especially with reference to the NZHGPA Instructor Code of Conduct.
4. To retain this rating the applicant must as per OPM:
 - a. Maintain currency of a First Aid certificate meeting NZHGPA standards
 - b. Maintain full a NZHGPA membership
 - c. Attended an official NZHGPA instructor seminar in the past 36months
