1. Tandem flight Examiners can be either a paragliding tandem commercial flight examiner or a paragliding instructor who is current and has held their paraglider tandem rating for a minimum of 2 years.
2. Examiner must check Pilot's Log to confirm Flight Log Requirements.
3. Pilot ratings are not effective until applications are processed by the NZHGPA and a rating card supplied to the pilot.
